John Griswold was home schooled and graduated from the St. Thomas More Home School and lives on Hilton Head Island. He will be attending Ave Maria University. John's high school average was 97.4 and his SAT total score was 2300. John was an alter server and sacristan at St. Francis by the sea Catholic Church. He is a member of the Civil Air Patrol and has the rank of Cadet 1st Lieutenant and Deputy Cadet Commander. He has competed in several triathalons and 5k, 10k, and half marathon races. John was also a finalist in the National Merit Scholarship Program. John is the son of Scott and Barbara Griswold of Hilton Head Island.



Brien Kurtz graduated from the South Carolina Governor's School for Science and Mathematics in Hartsville, SC. He will be attending the University of Notre Dame. Brien's high school average was 96.5 and his SAT total score was 2210. Brien received several highest grade awards in Human Geography, Pre-Calculus, English, and Biology. He was also Co-Captain of the Varsity Swim Team.
